BY-LAW No. 606-2000

To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations”, respecting the alteration of Power Street from Queen Street East to approximately 38 metres south by narrowing and realigning the pavement.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration was published in a daily newspaper on June 27, July 3, 10 and 17, 2000 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on July 18, 2000 and it is appropriate to amend the by-law to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations” is amended:

(1) by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, respectively, of Schedule “B-3” (Pavement Narrowing) the following:

Power Street	east	10.97m - 10.37m	Queen Street East	37.5m south	Q139-1 dated January, 2000
