BY-LAW No. 607-2000

To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations”, respecting the alteration of The Esplanade by constructing raised intersections with its intersections with Market Street and Church Street and by constructing sidewalk and boulevard enhancements on the south side of The Esplanade from Market Street to Lower Jarvis Street and respecting the repeal of By-law No. 189-2000 which authorized the construction of a median island on the east side of The Esplanade and Market Street intersection.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration was published in a daily newspaper on June 27, July 3, 10 and 17, 2000 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on July 18, 2000 and it is appropriate to amend the by-law to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations” is amended:

(1) by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, respectively, of Schedule “B-4” (Pavement Alteration/Repair) the following:

2. By-law No. 189-2000, being “A By-law to further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations”, respecting the alteration of The Esplanade west of Market Street by the construction of a pedestrian refuge median island” is repealed.
