CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 633-2000

To amend further By-law No. 181-81 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto respecting pensions and other benefits.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 24 of By-law No. 181-81 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, a by-law "To provide pensions and death benefits to members of the Metropolitan Police Force", as heretofore amended, is further amended by adding thereto the following subsections:

"Certain Pensioners with less than 30 Years' Service (4) Every pensioner member receiving benefits pursuant to section 11 as a result of having retired on or before the 1st day of April, 2000, with less than thirty years of service shall, subject to subsection (5), be entitled to a refund in an amount equal to that described in subclause (1)(b)(i)

Effectiveness of s.-s. (4) (5) Subsection (4) shall not come into operation until the Superintendent of Financial Services has given consent to the refund therein provided for, pursuant to subsection 63(7) of the Pension Benefits Act".

2. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment and passing.

ENACTED AND PASSED by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the Members of Council present and voting this 5th day of October, A.D. 2000.
