**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 636-2000**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** City of Toronto By-law No. 292-93, being a by-law to stop up and close to vehicular traffic a portion of the public lane south of Danforth Avenue, west of Kelvin and Luttrell Avenues and to authorize the erection of barricades to enforce the due observance thereof, is hereby repealed.
