CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 665-2000

To designate Lot 25 on Registered Plan 66M-2314 as being exempt from Part-Lot Control.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act* to pass this By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the lands described in the attached Schedule "A".
2. This By-law expires three years from the day of its enactment by Council.
