**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 708-2000**

**To exempt certain lands on Logan Avenue and Colgate Avenue,  
being certain lots within Plan of Subdivision 66M-2352, from the provisions of  
subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act which relate to part-lot control.**

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act,  
R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, shall not apply to the lands described in Schedule "A".
2. That this By-law shall expire thirty-six months from the day of its passage by Council.
