**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 712-2000**

**To name the public lane north of Dundas Street East between Dalhousie Street  
and Mutual Street “Frank Natale Lane”.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** Certain land being the public lane north of Dundas Street East between Dalhousie Street and Mutual Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of the Public Lane dedicated by City of Toronto By-law 575-1998 being part of Lot 26 on the east side of Dalhousie Street and part of Lot 26 on the west side of Mutual Street according to Plan 22A designated as PART 1 on Expropriation Plan 12129 (CA507019) both said Plans being registered in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64).

The east side of Dalhousie Street and the west side of Mutual Street as confirmed under the Boundaries Act by Plan BA-692 (CT131411)

is named Frank Natale Lane.
