CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 724-2000

To name the private lane at 1307 and 1309 Queen Street East “Agnes Lane”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The lane shown on Attachment No. 1 to this By-law dated June, 2000 is named Agnes Lane.
2. Eastend Developments Limited, its agent or successor shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs of fabrication and installation of the appropriate signage.
3. Eastend Developments Limited, its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this by-law.

ENACTED AND PASSED this 5th day of October, A.D. 2000.

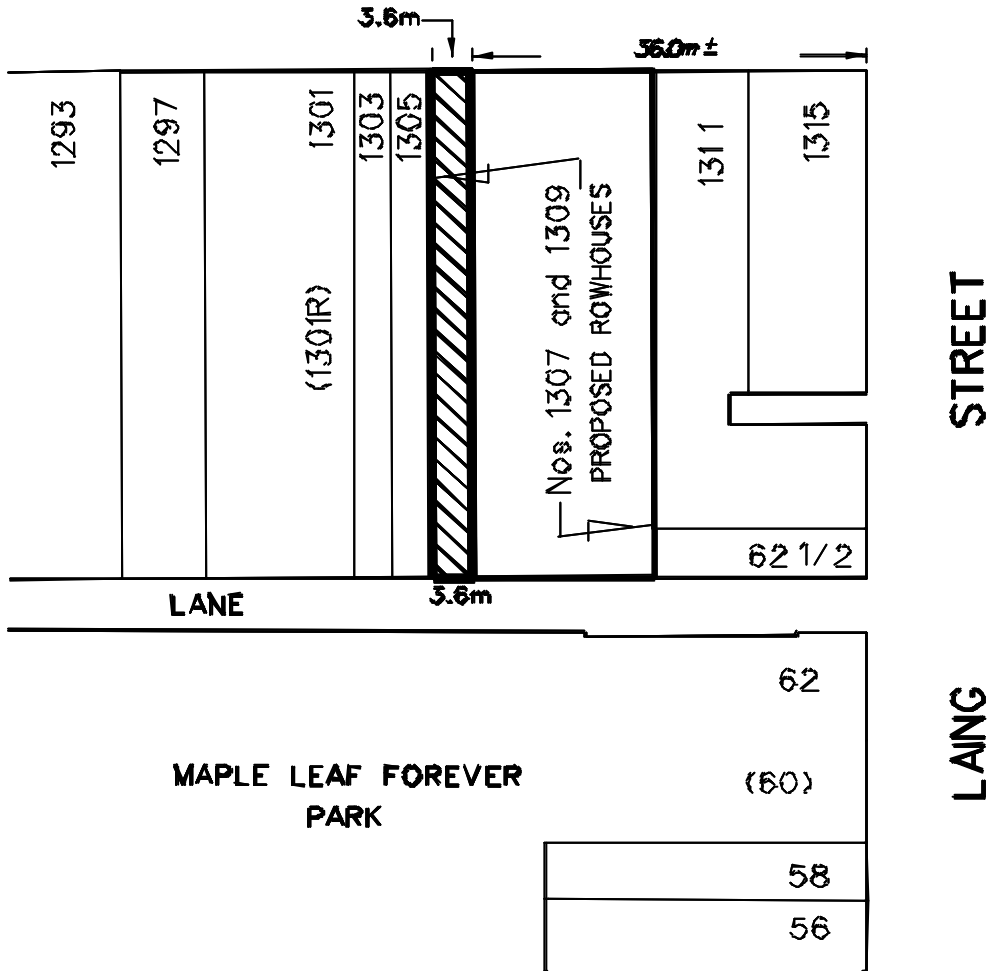
