CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 750-2000

To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations”, respecting the alteration of Robert Street at various locations from Harbord Street to Russell Street by narrowing the pavement.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration was published in a daily newspaper on August 19, 23 and 30 and September 6, 2000, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 7, 2000 and it is appropriate to amend the by-law to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations” is amended:

(1) by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, respectively, of Schedule “B-3” (Pavement Narrowing) the following:

Robert Street	West side	from: 6.4m to: 5.0-6:4m	Harbord Street	15 m south	421F-5746 and 421F-5747 dated June, 2000
Robert Street	West side	from: 6.4m to: 5.0-6:4m	9 m north of Russell Street	9 m south of Russell Street	421F-5746 and 421F-5747 dated June, 2000
