**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 753-2000**

**To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations”, respecting the alteration of Margueretta Street from College Street to Bloor Street West by the installation of of an island or planter in front of Premise Nos. 61 and 63.**

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration was published in a daily newspaper on August 19, 23 and 30 and September 6, 2000, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 7, 2000 and it is appropriate to amend the by-law to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations” is amended:

(1) by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, respectively, of Schedule “B-4” (Pavement Alteration/Repair) the following:

Margueretta Street	East	Alteration: installation of an island or planter	Premise No. 61	Premise No. 63	-----
