CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 754-2000

To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations”, respecting the alteration of Lower Spadina Avenue by widening the west section north of Queens Quay West by constructing a lay-by and by altering the existing concrete median and TTC passenger loading platform.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration was published in a daily newspaper August 19, 23 and 30 and September 6, 2000, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 7, 2000 and it is appropriate to amend the by-law to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations” is amended:

(1) by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, respectively, of Schedule “B-4” (Pavement Alteration/Repair) the following:

- (2) by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, respectively, of Schedule "B-2" (Pavement Widening) the following:

Lower Spadina Avenue	West section (southbound lanes) by construction of a lay-by	From: 7.1 m to: 7.1 - 9.1 m	12 m north of Queens Quay West	50 m further north	SK-2256 dated June, 2000
