BY-LAW No. 773-2000

To amend By-law No. 2958-94 of the former City of York, being a By-law “To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

PARKING FOR RESTRICTED PERIODS- SCHEDULE X

1. That Schedule X of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by deleting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of said Schedule the following:

2. That Schedule X of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of said Schedule the following:
