CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 790-2000

To repeal By-law No. 171-85 respecting the designation of an area on the north and south sides of Elm Street from Yonge Street to Barnaby Place as an Improvement Area, to repeal By-law No. 628-85 respecting the establishment of a Board of Management for the Elm Street Business Improvement Area and to amend Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 20, Business Improvement Areas.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 171-85 being a By-law “To designate an area on the north and south sides of Elm Street from Yonge Street to Barnaby Place as an Improvement Area” is repealed.
2. By-law No. 628-85 being a By-law “To establish a Board of Management for the Elm Street Business Improvement Area” is repealed.
3. Municipal Code, Chapter 20, Business Improvement Areas, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:
 - A. Schedule A, Maps is amended by deleting from the table “Elm Street” and by deleting the map entitled “Elm Street Business Improvement Area”.
 - B. The table in § 20-3 is amended by deleting in the first column “628-85” and by deleting in the third column “Elm Street Business Improvement Area”.
 - C. The table in Schedule A, Boards of Management is amended by deleting from the first column “Elm Street” by deleting from the second column “171-85”, by deleting from the third column “6”, by deleting from the fourth column “2”, by deleting from the fifth column “Downtown” and by deleting from the sixth column “3”.
4. This by-law shall come into force on December 31, 2000.
