BY-LAW No. 794-2000

**To establish a Road and Sidewalk Repair, Maintenance and Reconstruction Reserve Fund
and to amend By-law No. 181-2000, the Reserves and Reserve Funds By-law to add the new
reserve fund.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The Road and Sidewalk Repair, Maintenance and Reconstruction Reserve Fund is hereby established for the purpose of providing funding to reconstruct and repair roads that have been aged prematurely due to multiple pavement cuts by telecommunications carriers.
2. By-law No. 181-2000, the Reserves and Reserve Funds By-law is amended by:
 - (a) listing in Column 1 of Schedule "C", "Road and Sidewalk Repair, Maintenance and Reconstruction Reserve Fund";
 - (b) inserting in Column 2 of Schedule "C" "Provides funding for the purpose of funding the reconstruction and repair of roads that have been aged prematurely due to multiple pavement cuts by telecommunications carriers".
