**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 797-2000**

**To amend the former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code, Ch. 171, Newspapers.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 171, Newspapers, of the former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A. By striking out §171-3D of the former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code, Chapter 171, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“D. An application fee of \$55.00 per box will be charged. Also, an annual fee of \$18.50 per box, payable in advance and subject to applicable taxes, shall be charged to companies or individuals having newspaper vending boxes on sidewalks and untravelled portions of the highway in the City of Etobicoke. The fees herein shall automatically increase on the first day of January in each year by the percentage increase in the All Items Index of the Consumer Price Index (not seasonally adjusted) for the Toronto Census Metropolitan Area, published by Statistics Canada, during the twelve-month period ending on October 1 in the year immediately preceding the rate increase date”.

2. This by-law is effective from the date of City Council’s meeting of April 26, 27 and 28, 1999.
