**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 798-2000**

**To amend the former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code, Ch. 231, Streets and Sidewalks.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 231, Streets and Sidewalks, of the former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A. By striking out §231-28 of the former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code, Chapter 231, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“§231-28 **Additional fees**

In addition to the deposit referred to in §231-27, and prior to the construction of, or alteration to, any driveway that will provide vehicle access to a public road, the owner of the property or his or her representative shall pay the following permit fee(s):

1. Commercial or industrial or residential lots with more than ten (10) dwelling units:

\$520.00 per driveway access plus the actual cost of construction or alteration to the driveway(s), including the cost of new curbing, culverts, culvert extensions or extra-depth sidewalk sections (dependant on the number of sidewalk bays).

2. Residential lots of less than ten dwelling units in total:

\$60.00 per driveway access plus the actual cost of construction or alteration to the driveway(s), including the cost of new curbing, culverts, culvert extensions or extra-depth sidewalk sections (dependant on the number of sidewalk bays).

3. The fees herein shall automatically increase on the first day of January in each year by the percentage increase in the All Items Index of the Consumer Price Index (not seasonally adjusted) for the Toronto Census Metropolitan Area, published by Statistics Canada, during the twelve-month period ending on October 1 in the year immediately preceding the rate increase date”.

2. This by-law is effective from the date of City Council’s meeting of April 26, 27 and 28, 1999.
