CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 801-2000

To amend the former Borough of East York By-law No. 122-93, being “A By-law to licence and regulate boulevard parking in residential areas”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 122-93 of the former Borough of East York, being “A By-law to licence and regulate boulevard parking in residential areas”, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting a new Subsection 3.3(f) after Subsection 3.3(e) as follows:

“(f) the applicant has paid a one-time application fee of sixty dollars (\$60.00)”.

B. By amending Schedule “B” to By-law No. 122-93 of the former Borough of East York by deleting the phrase: “Annually: \$120.00 per Front Yard Parking Pad (\$10.00/month)” and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“Annually: \$84.00 per Front Yard Parking Pad (\$7.00/month)”.

2. This by-law is effective from the date of City Council’s meeting of April 26, 27 and 28, 1999.
