CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 803-2000

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Front Yard Parking.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
 - A. By striking out the phrase: “effective October 30, 1998, a non-refundable, one-time only application fee of two hundred and fifty-five dollars and four cents (\$255.04)” from §400-9D(4)(e)[1](a) of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 400, and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “a non-refundable, one-time only application fee of two hundred and sixty dollars (\$260.00)”.
 - B. By striking out the phrase: “effective June 1, 1992, an administrative, survey and inspection fee of fifty-one dollars and twenty-five cents (\$51.25)” from §400-9D(4)(e)[1](b) of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 400, and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “a one-time only application fee of two hundred and sixty dollars (\$260.00)”.
 - C. By striking out the phrase: “sixty dollars (\$60.00), effective July 5, 1996” from §400-47D(4) and inserting in lieu thereof the phrase: “eighty-four (\$84) dollars”.
 - D. By striking out the phrase: “two dollars and seventy cents (\$2.70) per square metre, effective January 1, 1993,” from §400-48D(2) of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 400, and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “eighty-four dollars (\$84.00)”.
2. This by-law is effective from the date of City Council’s meeting of April 26, 27 and 28, 1999.
