**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 804-2000**

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting the Issuance of Permits.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
  - A. By striking out the phrase: “thirty dollars (\$30.00) from §400-9B(10)(a) of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 400, and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “forty-two dollars (\$42.00)”.
  - B. By striking out the phrase: “five dollars (\$5.00)” from §400-9B(10)(c)[1] of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 400, and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “seven dollars (\$7.00)”.
  - C. By striking out the phrase: “for the seven-day period and thirty dollars (\$30.00) for the one-month period, payable in advance” from §400-9C(6) of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 400, and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “per week”.
2. This by-law is effective from the date of City Council’s meeting of April 26, 27 and 28, 1999.
