**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 806-2000**

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Ch. 313, Streets and Sidewalks, respecting Parking on Boulevards in Residential Areas.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 313, Streets and Sidewalks, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
  - A. By inserting in §313-40A(2) of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 313, after “§§400-9D” and before “and 400-47” the phrase: “, except for §400-9D(4),”
  - B. By striking out §313-40A(3) of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 313, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“(3) The annual fee of \$84.00 is paid by the applicant to the City of Toronto”.
  - C. By inserting a new Subsection (3.1) after Subsection (3) in §313-40A of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 313, as follows:

“(3.1) The applicant has paid a one-time application fee of \$60.00 to the City of Toronto”.
2. This by-law is effective from the date of City Council’s meeting of April 26, 27 and 28, 1999.
