CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 808-2000

To amend the former Borough of York By-law No. 3343-79, being “A By-law respecting streets in the Borough of York”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 3343-79 of the former Borough of York, as amended, being “A By-law respecting Streets in the Borough of York”, is amended as follows:
 - A. By striking out Subsection 3A(1) of By-law No. 3343-79 of the former Borough of York, as amended, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“(1) Subject to paragraph (2) hereof, the holder of a permit shall pay in advance an application fee of Fifty-Five Dollars (\$55.00) together with an annual charge of Eighteen Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$18.50) for each newspaper vending box and an application fee of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) per kiosk together with an annual fee of Sixty dollars (\$60.00) per square metre per kiosk with a minimum fee of One-hundred and thirty Dollars (\$130.00) per kiosk. The fees herein shall automatically increase on the first day of January in each year by the percentage increase in the All Items Index of the Consumer Price Index (not seasonally adjusted) for the Toronto Census Metropolitan Area, published by Statistics Canada, during the twelve-month period ending on October 1 in the year immediately preceding the rate increase date”.
 - B. By deleting Subsection 3A(2) from By-law No. 3343-79 of the former Borough of York, as amended, and re-numbering Subsections 3A(3), 3A(4) and 3A(5) as Subsections 3A(2), 3A(3) and 3A(4).
 - C. By inserting a new Subsection (5) after Subsection (4) in Subsection 3E of By-law No. 3343-79 of the former Borough of York, as amended, as follows:

“(5) The applicant for a permit shall pay in advance a permit fee of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per event, such fee to automatically increase on the first day of January in each year by the percentage increase in the All Items Index of the Consumer Price Index (not seasonally adjusted) for the Toronto Census Metropolitan Area, published by Statistics Canada, during the twelve-month period ending on October 1 in the year immediately preceding the rate increase date”.

2. This by-law is effective from the date of City Council's meeting of April 26, 27 and 28, 1999.
