CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 811-2000

To amend the former City of York Municipal Code, Ch. 954, Parking - Boulevard Non-Residential Area.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 954, Parking - Boulevard Non-Residential Area, of the former City of York Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A. By deleting Section 954.2.9 of the former City of York Municipal Code, Chapter 954, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“954.2.9 Licence - fee - annual

The person to whom a licence has been issued as provided by this Chapter shall pay in advance an annual fee of Two hundred and twenty dollars (\$220.00) per space or part thereof of boulevard with respect to which the licence was issued, such fee to automatically increase on the first day of January in each year by the percentage increase in the All Items Index of the Consumer Price Index (not seasonally adjusted) for the Toronto Census Metropolitan Area, published by Statistics Canada, during the twelve-month period ending on October 1 in the year immediately preceding the rate increase date”.

B. By deleting the phrase: “\$9.00 per month” from the first line in Section 954.2.10 of Chapter 954 of the former City of York Municipal Code and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “\$18.33 per month”.

C. By deleting the phrase “of \$50.00 has been paid” in Section 954.3.1 of Chapter 954 of the former City of York Municipal Code and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “of \$250.00 has been paid, such fee to automatically increase on the first day of January in each year by the percentage increase in the All Items Index of the Consumer Price Index (not seasonally adjusted) for the Toronto Census Metropolitan Area, published by Statistics Canada, during the twelve-month period ending on October 1 in the year immediately preceding the rate increase date”.

2. This by-law is effective from the date of City Council's meeting of April 26, 27 and 28, 1999.
