CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 812-2000

To amend the former City of York Municipal Code, Ch. 963, Parking - Disabled Boulevard - Residential, respecting fees.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 963, Parking - Disabled Boulevard - Residential, of the former City of York Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A. By deleting the phrase “of twenty-five cents per square feet of space or part thereof of boulevard with respect to which the licence was issued, a space being a minimum of 193.77 square feet” from Section 963.2.6 of the former City of York Municipal code Chapter 963 and inserting in lieu thereof the phrase: “of eighty-four dollars (\$84.00).

B. By adding a new Section 963.3.8 after Section 963.3.7 in the former City of York Municipal Code, Chapter 963, as follows:

“963.3.8 **Application - fee**

The licence provided for in Section 963.2.1 may be issued when the applicant has paid a one-time only application fee of \$60.00”.

2. This by-law is effective from the date of City Council’s meeting of April 26, 27 and 28, 1999.
