CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 814-2000

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Ch. 248, Parking Licences, respecting Annual Charges.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 248, Parking Licences, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
 - A. By striking out the phrase: “sixty dollars (\$60.), effective July 5, 1996,” from §248-5 of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 248, and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “eighty-four dollars (\$84.)”.
 - B. By inserting a new §248-5B after §248-5 as follows:

“§248-5B **Application – fee**

The person who applies for a licence under this chapter shall pay in advance an application fee of sixty dollars (\$60).

2. This by-law is effective from the date of City Council’s meeting of April 26, 27 and 28, 1999.
