CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 836-2000

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Commissioners Street, Don Roadway, Leslie Street, Saulter Street South, Villiers Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule VIII (Prohibited Turns) in §400-61, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Commissioners Street between Don Roadway and Leslie Street	Eastbound and Westbound	U-turns	Anytime

B. By deleting from Schedule XXIV (No Stopping) in §400-77, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Don Roadway	Both	Commissioners Street and Lake Shore Boulevard East	Anytime
Commissioners Street	South	Don Roadway and Leslie Street	Anytime
