BY-LAW No. 853-2000

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a By-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, a By-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4, between the words “Airdrie Road” and “Aldwych Avenue” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

(In Column 1 Road)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times & Days)
Aldwych Avenue	North	A point 23.0 metres west of Dewhurst Avenue and a point 27.1 metres west of Dewhurst Avenue	Anytime

2. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
