BY-LAW No. 855-2000

To amend By-law No. 307, a by-law “To designate certain locations in the Borough of East York as pedestrian crossovers”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That Schedule “A” of By-law No. 307, entitled “To designate certain locations in the Borough of East York as pedestrian crossovers”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by deleting the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Brentcliffe Road

At its intersection with the production westerly of the northerly limit of
Vanderhoof Avenue
