BY-LAW No. 857-2000

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400,
Traffic and Parking, respecting Carlaw Avenue, Commissioners Street,
Don Roadway, Leslie Street, Saulters Street South, Villiers Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XXIV (No Stopping) in §400-77, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Villiers Street	South	Don Roadway and Saulters Street South	6:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and 3: 30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., Mon. to Fri. except Public Holidays

2. This By-law shall be effective commencing on or about December 15, 2000.
