**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 884-2000**

**To amend the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 118 respecting  
No. 176 Yonge Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** By-law No. 118, being a By-law “Respecting Signs over Metropolitan Roads”, as amended, is further amended by adding the following section:

- 2G. Notwithstanding Section 2A of this By-law, signs extending over the west limit of Yonge Street and north limit of Richmond Street West adjacent to the structure on lands municipally known in the year 1999 as 176 Yonge Street may be permitted provided:
- (a) the overhead clearance of the sign is at least 2.74 metres above the level of the sidewalk and the sign does not extend more than 1.00 metre over the street line; and
  - (b) there is compliance with the requirements respecting the erection or alteration of signs specified in Sections 2 and 3.
