CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 887-2000

To amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 136-67 by changing the name of the park roadway in Budapest Park from Marine Drive to Budapest Lane.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 136-67, being “A By-law to designate part of Budapest Park for use as a park roadway, and to name such roadway, and to prohibit parking thereon” is amended by:

- A. Deleting the words “Marine Drive” in Section 2 and replacing them with “Budapest Lane”;
- B. Deleting the words “Marine Drive” in Section 3 and replacing them with “Budapest Lane”; and
- C. Deleting the words “Marine Drive” on the plan dated November 2, 1966 attached to the By-law (referred to in Section 2 of the By-law) and replacing them with “Budapest Lane”.
