CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 905-2000

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 107-86, respecting parking meters on former Metropolitan Roads.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of Metropolitan By-law No. 107-86, being a By-law “Respecting parking meters on former Metropolitan Roads”, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of the said Schedule:
