CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 937-2000

To amend the former Borough of York By-law No. 3491-80, being “A by-law to provide for night-time parking of motor vehicles on Borough of York highways”, to provide for carsharing parking permits.

WHEREAS City Council has decided to establish a new category of on-street parking permits for carsharing vehicles and has directed that all City by-laws pertaining to the issuance of parking permits be amended accordingly;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-Law No. 3491-80 of the former Borough of York, being “A By-law to provide for night-time parking of motor vehicles on Borough of York highways”, is amended by inserting a new section 22 after section 21, as follows:

- “22 (1) In this section, “Carsharing” shall mean the practice of sharing the use of one or more motor vehicles owned by a profit or non-profit residentially-based carsharing organization, where:
1. the motor vehicles are parked for convenient access within the area of the membership served by the organization; and
 2. persons using the motor vehicles are members of the carsharing organization who pay a refundable or non-refundable membership fee for the privilege of reserving and using the motor vehicles on a fee for use basis.
- (2) An applicant for a carsharing parking permit must complete a City application form, including the following information:
- (a) name and address of the registered owner of the vehicle;
 - (b) the licence number, make and year of the vehicle; and
 - (c) the date.
- (3) The provisions of Sections 1 to 10, 13, 14 and 17 to 21, shall apply to carsharing parking permits, with necessary modification.
- (4) A carsharing parking permit issued under this section shall contain the number of the permit, the name and address of the registered owner of the vehicle, the make, year and licence number of the vehicle, the location where the vehicle may be parked, and the month of issue of the permit.

- (5) A carsharing parking permit may be issued for street specific permit parking only where there are permit parking spaces available on the specific street or part of a street.
- (6) The total number of carsharing parking permits issued under City by-laws relating to permit parking shall not exceed 25 for the period from October 1, 2000 to September 30, 2001.
- (7) There shall be no fee payable for carsharing parking permits issued for the period set out in subsection 22(6)".
