CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 938-2000

**To amend the former City of York Municipal Code Ch. 985, Parking - Overnight, to
provide for carsharing parking permits.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 985, Parking - Overnight, of the former City of York is amended by inserting a new Section 985.2.22 after Section 985.2.21, as follows:

“985.2.22 Carsharing Parking Permits

- (a) In this section, “carsharing” shall mean the practice of sharing the use of one or more motor vehicles owned by a profit or non-profit residentially-based carsharing organization, where:
1. the motor vehicles are parked for convenient access within the area of the membership served by the organization; and
 2. persons using the vehicles are members of the carsharing organization who pay a refundable or non-refundable membership fee for the privilege of reserving and using the motor vehicles on a fee for use basis.
- (b) The applicant for a carsharing parking permit must complete a City application form, include the following information:
1. name and address of the registered owner of the motor vehicle;
 2. the licence number, make and year of the motor vehicle; and
 3. the date.
- (c) The provisions of Sections 985.1.1 to 985.1.6, 985.2.1 to 985.2.7, 985.2.9 to 985.2.11, 985.2.18 to 985.2.20 and 985.4.1 to 985.4.3 shall apply to carsharing parking permits, with necessary modification.
- (d) A carsharing parking permit may be issued for street specific permit parking only where there are permit parking spaces available on the specific street or part of a street.
- (e) The total number of carsharing parking permits issued under City by-laws relating to permit parking shall not exceed 25 for the period from October 1, 2000 to September 30, 2001.

- (f) There shall be no fee payable for carsharing parking permits issued for the period set out in subsection 985.2.22(e)".
