BY-LAW No. 963-2000

To amend former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 25, Community and Recreation Centres, to change the membership of the Ted Reeve Arena (175 Main Street) Committee of Management.

WHEREAS Ted Reeve Arena is located in the geographic area of the former City of Toronto and will be located in new Ward 32 on December 1, 2000; and

WHEREAS under subsection 1(1) of the *City of Toronto Act, 1991*, S.O. 1991, c. Pr24, despite subsection 5(1) of the *Community Recreation Centres Act*, a committee of management composed of five or more persons may have only one member of Council appointed to it;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 25-13 of Chapter 25, Community and Recreation Centres, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
 - A. Subsection C(1) is amended by deleting “eight (8)” and substituting “seven (7)”.
 - B. By deleting Subsection C(2)(a) and substituting the following:
 - (a) The member of Council for Ward 32.
2. This by-law comes into force on December 1, 2000.
