CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 47-2001

To amend Chapter 103, Heritage, of the Municipal Code to increase the number of Council members on the Colborne Lodge/Mackenzie House/Spadina House Community Museum Management Board.

WHEREAS the three museums managed by the Colborne Lodge/Mackenzie House/Spadina House Community Museum Management Board (the "Board") are now located in three different Community Council areas; and

WHEREAS it is considered desirable that each of the relevant Community Councils be able to nominate one of its members to sit on the Board; and

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2001, By-law No. 793-1999 has been codified as Article I, Museum Boards, of Chapter 103, Heritage, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 103, Heritage, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by:
 - A. Adding the following subsection immediately after §103-3B(3):

“(3.1) Despite Subsection B(2), the Southwest, Downtown, and Midtown Community Councils, or their respective successors, shall each nominate one of their members for appointment to the Management Board of Colborne Lodge/Mackenzie House/Spadina House.”
 - B. Deleting “1 or 2” from the first row of the column headed “Number of Council Members” in Section B of Schedule A and substituting “3” in its place.
