BY-LAW No. 54-2001

**To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the lane west
of Yonge Street extending southerly from Farnham Avenue.**

WHEREAS City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 415, Development of Land, Article II, delegated to the Chief Planner the authority to approve plans and drawings in relation to certain classes of development in areas of site plan control; and

WHEREAS as part of the Chief Planner's approval of plans for the development of 1320 Yonge Street, it was necessary to widen the lane west of Yonge Street extending southerly from Farnham Avenue;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land west of Yonge Street extending southerly from Farnham Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of part of Lot 23, part of the Lane and part of the One Foot Reserve on Plan 1317-York, the said Lane being closed by City of Toronto By-law No. 20468 (56604EM), designated as PART 1 on Plan 64R-15907, both said Plans being in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64)

is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes.
