BY-LAW No. 56-2001

To name the public lane east of Augusta Avenue extending northerly from Baldwin Street, "Littlehayes Lane".

WHEREAS certain land east of Augusta Avenue extending northerly from Baldwin Street was laid out by former City of Toronto By-law No. 308-85 and dedicated by By-law No. 230-86 of the former City of Toronto;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public lane east of Augusta Avenue extending northerly from Baldwin Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of the Public Lane dedicated by City of Toronto By-law No. 230-86 (CT785587), being part of Block K on Plan D-13 designated as PARTS 1, 2, 5, 6, 7 and 8 on Expropriation Plan CT70315, both said Plans being in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64)

is named Littlehayes Lane.
