BY-LAW No. 57-2001

To layout and dedicate certain land for public highway purposes and to name that land Lukow Terrace and to layout and dedicate certain land south of Wabash Avenue extending westerly from MacDonell Avenue for public lane purposes.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of part of Lot 4 on Plan 1256 and part of the 0.3 Reserve on Plan 468 - York designated as PART 1 on Plan 64R-16175, all of the said Plans being in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64)

is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes and named Lukow Terrace.

2. Certain land south of Wabash Avenue extending westerly from MacDonell Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of part of Lot 4 on Plan 1256, part of Lot 4 on Plan 462-York and part of the 0.3 Reserve on Plan 468 - York designated as PART 2 on Plan 64R-16175, all of the said Plans being in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64)

is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes.
