BY-LAW No. 67-2001

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 195, Purchasing, on an interim basis to authorize standing committees of Council to increase the award authority of the Bid Committee in cases of emergency.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 195, Purchasing is amended by adding the following new § 195-9C.1 after § 195-9C:
 - "C.1 "Despite § 195-8B(2) and § 195-9C, on an interim basis, a standing committee is authorized to delegate to the Bid Committee the authority to make an award if an emergency exists and if the amount of the award is equal to or less than the approval by Council and is equal to or less than \$3.5 million".
