BY-LAW No. 74-2001

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation
of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XI (No Standing) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Richmond Street West (M.T. 38)	South	A point 30 metres west of John Street and a point 14.5 metres further west thereof	Anytime

2. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures:

Kingston Road and Queen Street (M.T. 4)	Southbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule.
