2. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures:

Kingston Road and Southbound Right When traffic control signal Queen Street shows red (M.T. 4)

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule.
