BY-LAW No. 83-2001

To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations”, respecting the alteration of Rosemount Avenue from Dufferin Street to Oakwood Avenue by the installation of speed humps.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration was published in a daily newspaper on May 1, 8, 15 and 22, 2000 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on May 23, 2000 and a further notice was published on December 27, 2000, January 2, 8 and 15, 2001 and interested persons were given a further opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on January 16, 2001 and it is appropriate to amend the by-law to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations” is amended:

- (1) by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, respectively, of Schedule “B-4” (Pavement Alteration/Repair) the following:
