CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 117-2001

To amend the City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 59, Emergency Planning.

WHEREAS at its meeting held on March 4, 5 and 6, 1998, the Council of the City of Toronto enacted By-law No. 47-1998 establishing the framework for the City to respond to an emergency and to authorize a Toronto Emergency Planning Committee (the "Committee") to formulate an emergency plan; and

WHEREAS at its meeting held on July 27, 28, 29 and 30, 1999, the Council of the City of Toronto enacted By-law No. 455-1999 amending By-law No. 47-1998 to include a representative of the Ontario Hospital Association as a member of the Committee and to reflect changes to the standing committee structure of the Council of the City of Toronto; and

WHEREAS at its meeting held on October 3, 4 and 5, 2000 the Council of the City of Toronto enacted By-law No. 871-2000, adopting a municipal code for the City of Toronto and codified By-law No. 47-1998, as amended, as Ch. 59, Emergency Planning, of the Code; and

WHEREAS it is desirable and appropriate to amend Ch. 59 of the Code to reflect the establishment of an emergency planning office in the Department of Works and Emergency Services of the City of Toronto;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection A of § 59-2 of the Code is amended by adding the following:

(13) The Manager, Emergency Planning, City of Toronto Emergency Planning Office.
2. Subsection J of § 59-10 of the Code is deleted and replaced by the following:

J. The Manager, Emergency Planning, City of Toronto Emergency Planning Office.
3. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
