BY-LAW No. 143-2001

**To rename the portion of Kipling Avenue south of Lake Shore Boulevard West
“Colonel Samuel Smith Park Drive”.**

WHEREAS notice of a public hearing on February 14, 2001 with respect to the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was advertised in a daily newspaper on January 23, 29, February 5 and 12, 2001, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard, and it is appropriate to rename the portion of Kipling Avenue south of Lake Shore Boulevard West as “Colonel Samuel Smith Park Drive”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of Kipling Avenue south of Lake Shore Boulevard West, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 07596-0236 (LT)

Being Kipling Avenue on Plan 66M-2319 registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Metropolitan Toronto (No. 66)

in the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of Etobicoke) and Province of Ontario is renamed Colonel Samuel Smith Park Drive.
