BY-LAW No. 144-2001

To rename Loblaws Lane as “No Frills Lane”.

WHEREAS notice of a public hearing on February 13, 2001 with respect to the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was advertised in a daily newspaper on January 23, 29, February 5 and 12, 2001, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard, and it is appropriate to rename Loblaws Lane as “No Frills Lane”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The lane north of Eglinton Avenue East extending from Brimley Road to Danforth Road named Loblaws Lane, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 06355-0323 (LT)

Being the Service Lane on Plan 4672 registered in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64)

in the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario is renamed No Frills Lane.
