BY-LAW No. 155-2001

**To layout and dedicate certain land west of Royal York Road for public highway purposes
to form part of the public highway The Queensway.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land west of Royal York Road, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S.,
City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 07525-0302 (LT)

Being part of Wadsworth Crescent on Plan 3588, renamed as part of The Queensway by
Township of Etobicoke By-law 8374, closed and stopped up by City of Etobicoke By-law
1989-192 (Instrument TB637429) designated as PART 1 on Plan 64R-12288, both of the
said Plans being in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry
Division (No. 64)

in the City of Toronto (formerly the City of Etobicoke) and Province of Ontario is laid
out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of The Queensway.
