The southerly limit of Bevdale Road and the easterly limit of Senlac Road as confirmed under the Boundaries Act By Plan BA-358 (registered as Plan 9280, Instrument NY625587) and Plan BA-636 (registered as Plan 9912, Instrument NY677407), respectively.

In the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of North York) and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of Bevdale Road.
