CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 158-2001

To layout and dedicate certain land on the east side of Meadowvale Road extending northerly from White Avenue for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Meadowvale Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land on the east side of Meadowvale Road extending northerly from White Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 06229-0133 (LT)

Being part of Lot 2 on Plan 3499 registered in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64) designated as PART 4 on Plan 66R-18313 deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Metropolitan Toronto (No. 66)

in the City of Toronto (formerly the City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of Meadowvale Road.
