**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 160-2001**

**To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations”, respecting the alteration of Millwood Road from Acacia Road to Mount Pleasant Road by the installation of speed humps.**

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration was published in a daily newspaper on January 23, 29, February 5 and 12, 2001 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on February 13, 2001 and it is appropriate to amend the by-law to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations” is amended:
  - (1) by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, respectively, of Schedule “B-4” (Pavement Alteration/Repair) the following:
