CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 175-2001

**To amend former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, to
reflect an increase in set fines for fire route offences.**

WHEREAS City Council has directed that the set fine for fire route offences be increased to \$100.00 and that an application be made to the Senior Regional Judge for this purpose; and

WHEREAS the Senior Regional Judge will not allow early voluntary payments to be in amounts less than two-thirds of the amount of the proposed set fine;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking is amended by deleting from § 400-11B(1), across from the “400-45 (fire routes), under Column 2 and Column 3, the following amounts:

Column 1	Column 2	Column 3
	1 to 7 Days	8 to 15 Days
400-45 (fire routes)	“20.00	30.00”

and replacing those amounts with “70.00 and 100.00”, respectively.

2. Section 1 of this By-law comes into effect upon the approval of the set fine by the Senior Regional Judge.
